Formal Portraits: Taking formal portraits can be time consuming, keeping your guests waiting. Estimate about two minutes per pose to get everyone in it, arranged, and the pictures taken. Time can be saved by doing as many shots as possible before the ceremony. Typically as many shots as possible are taken before the ceremony with Bride and Groom separate and the rest with the Bride and Groom together are taken after the ceremony before the reception.
